Emergency dental procedures cover a wide range of circumstances, but the most common emergency procedure is a tooth that is eliminated, a filling or crown coming out or a cracked tooth. There are times when a dental problem can wait until the next day to be examined, but if you are in a situation where the pain and severity of your case are extreme, it is important to have a plan in place. It can be difficult to know what is the best option when you are in a dental emergency situation. The first thing you should do is call our office, even if the incidence occurs after working hours. If you are able to make an emergency appointment, it is a good idea to be ready to answer the following questions: What caused this event? Was it an accident or the result of a long-term problem? How long ago did the event happen? What is your current level of pain? Are you taking medications your dentist should be aware of? Do you have a history of dental problems that may have a factor in determining the type of care you need to receive? If you are unable to reach us, you can always be treated in the emergency room of a local hospital. It is preferable to avoid going to the hospital emergency room if you can help him, mainly because the staff is not trained to handle specialized dental emergency procedures. In addition, the cost of being seen can be high; however, if this is your best option, don't hesitate to take this route. At the very least, emergency room doctors will be able to advise you on what your best path to treatment is and will likely be able to prescribe antibiotics and/or painkillers if necessary. One of the most common reasons for an emergency dental examination is the sudden and unexpected loss of a tooth. If you have found you are in this situation, the first thing to be aware of is that it is important to handle the tooth the least If you are able, reposition the tooth in its socket and gently bite a dampened gauze on the tea bag until you can have it examined. If it is not possible to set the tooth in its socket, quickly wash the tooth and inspect it to make sure that there is no dirt debris, and then put the tooth in a container filled with a glass of milk or, if possible, your own saliva. While you're waiting to be seen by your dentist or surgeon, you may want to place a cold compress to relieve swelling and slow bleeding. Crowns or fillings can occasionally come off while eating, especially while eating harder foods. If the crown or filling should peel off, this is generally an indication that the area under that tooth has begun to decay, which has changed the shape of the tooth, with the result that the crown no longer fits properly. In that case, it is important to call our office as soon as possible. In the meantime, be sure to store the crown in a cool and safe space and transport it to a sanitized container, as we may be able to reinsert it. The final cost of your emergency dental procedure will be determined by a variety of factors, such as when the emergency occurs, the severity of your case, and the type of dental plan you are currently enrolled in.
